Washing of the Feet

"I have given you an example so that you may copy what I have done to you."

Washing their feet during a supper he took with them, "before the feast of Passover", Jesus showed his disciples what they must do. "I have given you a model to follow,". Now we can understand it, for we have seen how he loved his own "till the end", even dying for them, so that they might have a "share with him", in his inheritance, after he passes from this world to his Father.

"God is Love" (1 John 4:8, 16). This is not an abstract definition, but a very concrete one, because, "the way we came to know love was that he laid down his life for us (1 John 3:16), and he commands us to "love one another as I have loved you". As he has loved us, we too ought to lay down our lives for our brothers. There have always been, and will always be, some Christians for whom "to lay down one's life for one's brother means precisely this. But, every disciple of the Lord must live for others, knowing that, to guard one's life for one's sake is to lose it. To understand and accept this, we must look to Jesus' model. He goes before us to the Father, without leaving us to our own devices on the paschal road.
