John Fisher School

Each year we are oversubscribed, and one of the main reasons for this and why some applicants were not able to gain a place with us was because parents/carers did not complete the required Supplementary Information Form (SIF). As stated in our Admissions Policy there are two stages of application to be completed. Firstly Parents/carers must put us as one of their school choices with their Local Authority, using the Common Application Form (CAF) from 1st September and by the closing date 31st October each year. Secondly Parents/carers **must** complete and return a SIF with supporting documents (and evidence if necessary) to us at The John Fisher school, by the closing date 31st October each year. SIF's can be downloaded from the school website www.johnfisherschool.org and returned via post or in person, or you can collect them directly from the school. If you return your completed SIF and original supporting documents /evidence by post, we ask that you please provide a correctly stamped address envelope for us to return the documents back to you.
