

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL

The term of office for the elected members of the current Parish Pastoral Council is coming to an end, and we will be inviting parishioners for new nominations.

The Parish Pastoral Council comprises a group of members who assist the Parish Priest in his leadership of the Parish. It is a consultative body with the aims:

1. To assist the Parish Priest, as he shall from time to time require, in all matters relating to the administration, general welfare and development of the Parish.
2. To coordinate the work of committees, sub-committees or other action groups, as may from time to time be constituted.
3. To facilitate, through the representative role of the members, the rights of the members of the Church, by making known their needs to the Parish Priest and to the other members of the Church.

We will make available the form for the nominations in due course, and any member of the parish is eligible. In the meantime, let us consider the people we will nominate to serve on the Parish Pastoral Council.
