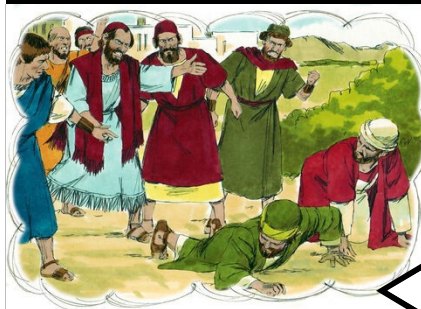


4th July 2021: Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Something to think and pray about each day of the week

Laudato Si' (May You be praised) has channelled massive energy into care of our Common Home. Pope Francis shares with all humankind the crucified Christ's challenge to St Francis of Assisi in 1205: "Francis, go and repair my house which as you see is falling into disrepair." Note the divine command, 'Go'. *Laudato Si* is interwoven with a strong thread of hope, as the following encouraging quotations show:

Hope would have us recognize that there is always a way out. (61) All it takes is one good person to restore hope. (70) We must speak of the figure of a Father who creates and who alone owns the world. (74) The God who created the universe out of nothing can also intervene in this world and overcome every form of evil. (75) A spirituality which forgets God as all powerful and Creator is not acceptable. (75)

Jesus has taken to himself this material world (22), and through his Incarnation definitive transformation (235). The ultimate destiny of the universe is in the fullness of God (83). The world is now journeying toward its final perfection (80) The Eucharist is itself an act of cosmic love which penetrates all creation, for in the bread of the Eucharist creation is projected towards divinization, towards its final transfiguration (236) We come together to take charge of this home which has been entrusted to us, knowing that all the good which exists here will be taken up into the heavenly feast. Let us sing as we go. May our struggles and our concern for this planet never take away the joy of our hope. (244) (Sacredspace)

About this thing, I have pleaded with the Lord three times for it to leave me, but he has said, 'My grace is enough for you: my power is at its best in weakness.' GOSPEL - Mark 6: 1-6

Jesus went to his home town and his disciples accompanied him. With the coming of the sabbath he began teaching in the synagogue and most of them were astonished when they heard him. They said, 'Where did the man get all this? What is this wisdom that has been granted him, and these miracles that are worked through him? This is the carpenter, surely, the son of Mary, the brother of James and Joset and Jude and Simon? His sisters, too, are they not here with us?' And they would not accept him. And Jesus said to them, 'A prophet is only despised in his own country, among his own relations and in his own house'; and he could work no miracle there, though he cured a few sick people by laying his hands on them. He was amazed at their lack of faith.

PROFESSION OF FAITH
