

Sharing the Word

First Reading (Eccles 1:2; 2:21-23) This reading casts a cold eye on the vanity of human life. One example of this vanity is the toil that people put into acquiring wealth only to leave it all to their heirs. Things that are supposed to satisfy human beings do not satisfy them. Only faith in God and in an afterlife can provide a light in the darkness.

Second Reading (Colossians 3:1-5. 9-11)

This reading sums up some of the conclusions that follow from the fact that through baptism the Christian shares in the life of Christ. As believers we do not model ourselves on the behaviour of the world but on the behaviour of Christ whose life we share.

Gospel (Luke 12:13-21)

The gospel deals with the difficulties that possessions can cause for the disciples of Jesus. Jesus refuses to get involved in a family dispute. He focuses on cause of the dispute which is greed for possessions. The parable stresses the foolishness of depending on material things for one's security rather than on God. In his search for security and happiness in this life, the rich man forgets God, eternal life, and his obligations to the poor. He is truly a fool because he has not known how to use wisely the wealth that he had. And so the gospel wants us to decide between the fragile security and illusory joy of earthly wealth and the true riches of possessing God.
