

#### Sharing the Word

##### First Reading

This reading is part of the dialogue between God and the prophet. Like others before him, Habakkuk is feeling the burden of office. He complains about the prevalence of injustice and God's failure to intervene. Then comes the divine response: in due time God will intervene to save those who trust in him. Meanwhile, the upright must remain steadfast in faith.

##### Second Reading

Paul calls on Timothy to rekindle the gift (of courage and power) he received when he was consecrated as an apostle. He must never be ashamed of witnessing to the Lord. He is urged to accept his share of suffering for the Gospel. With the help of the Holy Spirit he will be faithful to his charge to the end.

##### Gospel

A slave had no claim to either wages or thanks from his master, irrespective of how well he might have served him. At the time of Jesus, Judaism was dominated by the notion of merit. God owed salvation to human beings in return for keeping the Law. Jesus rejects this and emphasizes God's sheer goodness. The disciple must not claim a reward for doing what God expects of them. They must remember that they are only servants.

#### Baptism of Infants

During COVID we did not require parents seeking the baptism of their children to do a baptism preparation

course. But it is now a requirement that parents attend a baptism preparation course before they bring their children for baptism. A baptism preparation course will be held in the presbytery on every first Saturday of the month.
