Mon 19 09.30	Wellbeing for Chichi Maduaka Rosary	<h3>Sharing the Word</h3> <p>First Reading: The prophet is counselling King Ahaz at a time when the dynasty of David was in jeopardy. The king refuses a sign from God. He has no confidence in the help of Yahweh, and has already made up his mind to seek the help of Assyria. But he will have a sign whether he wills it or not. The queen is pregnant with the one who will continue the threatened line. .</p> <p>Second Reading: Paul designates himself as "servant" and "apostle", called by God to preach the Good News that God's promises have been fulfilled in Jesus Christ. Jesus is a descendant of David through human origin and was proclaimed the Son of God through his resurrection from the dead.</p> <p>Gospel: "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son and they will call him Emmanuel, a name which means 'God is with us'. Matthew refers to this prophecy from Isaiah. The Child to be born of a virgin, will embody God's promise to be with us and continue David's line for ever. Jesus is the son of David because Joseph, his legal father, was descended from the line of David. But he is more than that. He is the Son of God.</p>
