## **Sharing the Word**

#### First Reading

God promises to make a covenant with the Israelites. Yahweh chooses the people of Israel. They will be his chosen people only in so far as they keep their side of agreement. Yahweh confers onto them a special mission, to show in their lives the universal saving plan of God.

#### Second Reading

Paul talks about God's amazing love for us. The proof of that love lies in the fact that Christ died for us while we were still sinners.

#### Gospel

Jesus chooses the twelve apostles. The old Israel was founded on twelve tribes and so the new Israel will be founded on twelve apostles. And Jesus felt compassion for the ordinary people. They were dejected because they lacked true leaders. And so he sends his disciples on a mission. This mission mirrors that of Jesus in word and work.

The first task of the apostles was preaching. They were to alert people to the presence of the kingdom of God. Their second task was healing. He gave them power to heal and authority over unclean spirits. For the moment their mission is limited to 'the lost sheep of the house of Israel'. After his resurrection, they will be formally commissioned to undertake a universal mission.
