

Advent

We begin another Advent season of watching and waiting. For some it is a time of delight, waiting eagerly for Christmas, for anticipated gifts, for time off from work and school, and for happy gatherings of family and friends. For others it is a dreaded time, as they approach the first holiday without a loved one or worry about how they will pay for the gifts and meals they want to provide. Whatever our situation the scripture readings during advent help us to adopt a stance of faithful watching and waiting. It is a time we seek to know the ways of Emmanuel, "God with us."

Sharing the Word

First Reading

This is a lament over the misfortunes that have befallen God's people. Isaiah entreats God to come and save his people. He recalls God's goodness and candidly acknowledges the ingratitude and sinfulness of his people. Only God can deliver the people from their plight.

Second Reading

Paul gives thanks for the many charismatic gifts God has bestowed on the Corinthians. He is confident that as they wait for Christ's coming in glory, God will keep them steadfast in bearing witness to him.

Gospel

Today's Gospel urges us to stay awake at our appointed task, because we do not know the hour when Jesus will return. We must live in such a way as to be always ready to meet the Lord. For the faithful, the Lord's coming is not something to fear, it is something to look forward to because the Lord will come as redeemer and not as judge.

Church Heating
