#### Sharing the Word

#### First Reading

Now that David was king of a united country, with Jerusalem as the capital, he set about building a house (temple) for the Lord. But the Lord pre-emptied David's plan. Instead it is the Lord who will build a dynasty for David, a dynasty that will last forever. God's promise to David was fulfilled in Jesus. Gabriel's words to Mary echo the words of God's promise to David. Jesus fulfilled the messianic hope of Israel, and now he fulfils our hopes.

#### **Second Reading**

The three verses from Paul's letter to the Romans remind us that human beings, cannot understand how God works within human history. The mystery of God is revealed in the person of Jesus the Christ, the one whose mystery we ponder this season.

#### Gospel

Luke is the only evangelist who recounts for us the annunciation of the births of both John the Baptist and Jesus. Today we focus on Mary's response to the announcement that she will give birth to a son and name him Jesus, and that he will be recognized as "Son

of the Most High." Further Mary is told that the Lord God will give him the throne of David his father, and he will rule over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end.

Mary is the model disciple; one who hears the word of God and does it.

Archbishop John Wilson has recorded his annual Christmas message for the Archdiocese, calling for us all to embrace prayer and welcome Christ into our hearts. He reminds us that: "if we ask, we will be heard. If we seek, we will be found. If we knock, the Lord Jesus
