SOCIETY FOR THE PROTECTION OF UNBORN CHILDREN (SPUC)

In April, the Crime and Policing Bill, which removes all criminal liability for a woman carrying out her own abortion, received Royal Assent. It is now no longer criminal for a woman to abort her own baby, up to birth, for any reason in England and Wales.

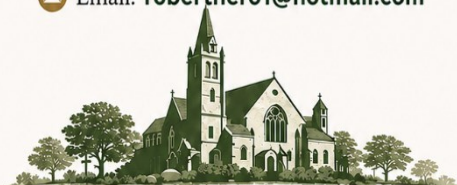
